Former Mathematician and NASA scientist Dr Steve Otto is now the Director of Research and Testing at golf's world governing body The R&A. Dr Otto has published a wide range of articles describing the fate of fluid flows, bubbles, micro-organisms and more recently material on the physics of golf.

His session on Wednesday has the title 'a few facts about distance'. Be prepared to be enlightened and even challenged about perceptions on golf equipment.

There are many misconceptions concerning the physics of impact and analysis of the game. Frequently comments concerning the state of the game are made on the basis of limited experience and anecdotal information.

This presentation will give details of data gathered over the last couple of decades on driving distance and accuracy for golfers of all levels. This will be set in context with a description of the evolution of technology and the equipment Rules over a similar period.
